KEYNOTE: LAW PRACTICE IN THE AGE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY By Prof Ernest Ojukwu, SAN At The OB LULU-BRIGGS FOUNDATION LAW STUDENTS' GRANT WARD CEREMONY On Monday December 18, 2017 at NBA House Port Harcourt

I like to quote the extensive statement of Sarah Kellopp¹ that:

"The legal profession is experiencing an era of turbulence and transformation. Some have an aversion to change, others worry about losing ground, and still others are concerned that the headlong rush to remake the profession will cause a shift from the practice of law to the business of law, with the profession losing its moral and cultural footing along the way.

The leading edge of that future is already visible: paper pushing and data management long practiced by lawyers are making way for computers and robots, international boundaries are more legally porous than ever, and economic forces are refashioning law practices. Consumer trends such as do-it-yourself legal services and legal smartphone apps are now ubiquitous. And clients are playing a larger role in managing their legal portfolios.

These changes are significant, even revolutionary, and they will be magnified exponentially in the years to come. The transformation of the profession will be remarkably agnostic when it comes to law firms, experts say, applying equal pressure to solo practitioners as well as to the largest global firms. The responsibility for accommodating all this radical change will fall most heavily on the individual attorney, who must be nimble, savvy, and swift in responding to these fast-moving currents."

In other places, technology is having a tremendous effect on the legal profession. "The lawyers who are going to be in a good position and will do fine in the future are the lawyers who understand the technology and its limits, and [who] understand where they can add the value that technology cannot provide."²

Law is a business and our Universities, the Nigerian Law School, The Bar and the individual lawyers must clearly have that focus that law is a business with some ethical rules that guide it.

To begin to contemplate our roles in this technology revolution, it is necessary to know and begin to understand what is already in the market in relation to legal practice.

BACK HOME

Examples of software and Apps shown above are being replicated and developed by few young citizens and young lawyers in Nigeria.

We have seen the use and benefit of online law reporting. The National Judicial Council has initiated a campaign for case management software for our courts and a legal mail for all lawyers who wish to practice in the Supreme Court. We have seen the roll out of the CAC online platform and the shrinking of jobs for lawyers.

SHAMEFUL MANUAL OPERATED COURT SYSTEM

In spite of the progress of technology our courts still operate as full manual courts where judges still record proceedings in long hands.

As **Young lawyer at 7 years at the Bar**, I Presented a Paper at the NBA 1991 Annual Bar Conference Owerri on the topic: **"Executive Lawlessness and Judicial Helplessness in the Administration of Justice: A need to Plug Up the Holes".** In that Paper in 1991 I suggested among other things the abolishing of "the system of recording in long hand."

Regrettably 27 years later in 2018 our judges still record proceedings in long hand!

YOUNG LAWYERS MUST RECOGNISE THEIR HANDICAPS

In spite of the advanced technology in the World, and the use of advanced technology, our young lawyers largely lack real computer and internet communication skills. These primary skills must be acquired for a young lawyer to be capable of leaping into the technology world and real value based job market.

CHALLENGES

While I agree that most of our young lawyers are victims of poor legal education at the LLB level, the stadium legal training at the Nigerian Law School, and victims of **a disinterested Bar Association**, we must note that every **CHALLENGE IS AN OPPORTUNITY!**

As stated by Sarah Kellopp, "the challenge for the profession, its leaders, and its foot soldiers is to be more creative and visionary in considering what to do next. This won't be a journey for the fainthearted or the nonaligned"³. The challenge of unemployment in today's Nigeria and the "uncertainty in the current business climate may not subside soon, but there will be lawyers taking risks and rolling the dice on the future of the profession."⁴
